

Advice for Yearly Plan

- 1) Our overall goal should be reflected in the objectives.
- 2) Our objectives should be achievable, not too comprehensive or lofty, and for this year.
- 3) We should be able to "show progress" at the end of the year.
- 4) Growth is incremental and so should be our expectations. (modest not sweeping)
- 5) Measurable growth inspires immeasurable hope.
-don't try to do too much too quickly
- 6) We should be consistently seeking the Lord for His heart, His mind, His plan.
- 7) Be adaptable, flexible, and move toward the light.
- 8) Every person has a critical path for evangelism. Each is different.
- 9) Yet each person and child can grow in certain Christian character areas preparing the way for the Lord.
- 10) Big peer events seem to be very helpful for "jumpstarting" people.
- 11) For parent/child plan, consider what tools, activities, events, groups and relationships might serve the objectives.
- 12) Plan for the financial cost of each objective.
- 13) The plan should have a "price" (not just \$) for the children too. (Early experiences of the cross for the sake of the kingdom)
