1. Review of prayer and thoughts for the family;

4. Review the schedule
 - I have a dentist appointment: Tues, 1:00 PM
 - are the Browns still coming to Ford's day?
 - Don't agree to anything on Friday night.
5. Review areas that we're working on
 - 1) Let's keep trying to get Jane to clean her room.
 - 2) Jack's prayer time should be right after school or he'll miss it!
 - 3) Family prayer is going well.
6. Pastoral direction for wife
 - I'd like you to take some of your quiet time to list things (a few each day) for which you are grateful
7. New plans and concerns
 - We have to start saving for the community retreat.
 - In the first week of January we'll have an extended session to review and improve our plans for the children.
